KEY STRATEGIES

Involve faculty and students in recruiting; maintain a consistent presence at recruiting events

Offer summer programs and recruit for them

De-emphasize GRE scores; work with Admissions Committee

Put as much effort into retention as recruitment

Individualize curricula; offer deceleration if necessary

Provide academic and social support

Invite diverse speakers, including program alumni

Celebrate accomplishments, including fellowships, activities in organizations, etc.
