- A summary describing efforts to advance women through women's programs/initiatives, individual faculty and women's research (1-3 pages)
- Organization's bio: a program summary outlining outcomes of achievements (300 word limit)
- Organizational/program curriculum vitae – List key organizational/program leaders involved with the program, history, evolution of the program, transitions, important markers in growth, roles and responsibilities of individuals, activities sponsored, key collaborations and partnerships with internal/external groups or departments (5 page limit)
