



## 2004 AAMC Women in Medicine Call for Abstracts and Posters “Showcasing Women’s Leadership”

### Background

Does your institution have a thriving women in medicine program that could serve as a model for other medical schools? Have you developed a longitudinal/interdisciplinary program in women’s health? Are you developing a leadership training program that addresses unique issues of men and women?

The AAMC Women in Medicine Coordinating Committee is seeking to highlight innovative women’s leadership programs and women’s health research during the AAMC annual meeting during the first ever Women in Medicine Poster Reception, “Showcasing Women’s Leadership” on Sunday, November 7, 2004, 5:00 - 6:30 pm, Boston, MA.

Examples of abstracts submitted may range from a:

- Report of research or project development
- Description of new partnerships resulting in advancing women and/or faculty awareness of gender difference
- Curriculum advancing women’s health through multiple departments or levels of education
- Innovative solutions to old challenges such as harassment and discrimination

Abstracts that will be given strong consideration will include the following components in their program/research description:

- Demonstrate ability to achieve significant outcome and sustain change
- Promote collaboration
- Value the involvement of faculty, students and community

### Abstract Submission Guidelines

Abstracts must not exceed 300 words, and must include the following:

- Title, Authors, Institution
- Purpose of program/study/research
- Methodology, including study of design and analysis
- Summary of results
- Conclusions



A selection panel will review, judge and select abstracts by using the following criteria:

- Clarity of purpose
- Interpretation of results
- Originality of Approach or Question
- Clarity of Writing
- Strength or relevance of research design and instrumentation
