

Moving from a Networked/Multiple User Installation to a Local/Single User Installation

1. Locate the **ERASSERV.K10** directory. It should reside either on a network or shared drive. If you do not know where it is, log into the PDWS software and click **System | System Information**.
 - You will see the parameter **Server Path** in blue and underlined. The value for this is where your **ERASSERV.K10** is located.

Note: The software must be closed before copying the **ERASSERV.K10** folder.

2. This entire directory (**ERASSERV.K10**) needs to be moved from the network/shared drive to the PC's local drive (C:). Right click the **ERASSERV.K10** directory and click **Copy**.
3. Open the local drive where you want to move the **ERASSERV.K10** directory by either using **My Computer** or **Windows Explorer**. Right click anywhere in the local drive window and click **Paste**.

Tip: Make sure that users of the PDWS software have full access to the **ERASSERV.K10** directory as well as either Power User or Administrator privileges on their local PCs. The program will need to read, write, execute, and delete contents in this directory. Browse the **File Structures and Permissions** section for more information.

4. Once the **ERASSERV.K10** directory is copied over, reinstall the pdwsetup.exe, so the **Program Director's Workstation** is properly mapped to the correct drive.

To uninstall the PDWS:

1. Click **Start | Programs | ERAS 2010 | Uninstall Program Director's Workstation 2010**.
2. Select the **Automatic Uninstall Method**.
3. Click **Next** to continue.
4. Click **Finish**.
