

Multiple Specialty Installation

If your program has multiple specialties that need to reside in one ERAS PDWS software application, please follow the instructions below.

1. Select the **Networked/Multiple Users** option. In order to install multiple specialties, you will have to select both checkboxes:
 - Check **Do not install the program files on this computer.**
 - Check I would like to install multiple Program/Specialty units all at once.
2. Click **Next**.
 - The Multiple Unit Information screen will display.
3. Select **ADD** to type in the Unit Information for your first specialty.
4. After entering the Login ID, Validation String, Program Name and Specialty, click **Ok**.
5. Select **Add** to continue adding the Unit Information for more specialties. When finished, click **Next**.
6. Indicate the drive and directory where the PDWS server should reside. The default directory is **C:/ERASSERV.2K9**. To accept the default directory, click the **Next** button.
 - If you wish to share applicant data with other users on your network, change C:/ to the appropriate network drive (e.g., I:/). To specify the network drive, click on **Browse**, and then locate the network drive by clicking on the down arrow next to the default drive of 'C'. Click **Ok** and verify drive selection, then click **Next**.
7. You are now ready to install, click **Next**.
 - The Server portion of the Program Director's Workstation software will be installed.
 - All of the specialties will reside in the same **ERASSERV.2K9** directory.
8. Once the server files are installed, you will need to install the **Client** portion of the PDWS software. A new directory was created on either your hard drive or network drive (as you specified in the installation) with the name **{drive letter}:\ERASSERV.2K9**. In that directory, you will find a file called **pdwsetup.exe**. To complete the PDWS installation process double-click this file.

OR

Click **Start** and choose **Run**. In the Run dialog box, type **{server drive}:\ERASSERV.2K9\pdwsetup.exe**, then click **Ok**.

9. After double-clicking **pdwsetup.exe** the **Program Director's Workstation Setup** window will appear. Click **Next**.
10. The Select Program dialog box appears. Highlight the program you wish to install and click **Next**.

11. You will now be asked if you would like this workstation to have the ability to contact the ERAS PostOffice. Your choice will affect the workstation's ability to contact the ERAS PostOffice to download and upload data. The **ERAS Program Director's Workstation Set-up** dialog box appears. Click **Next**.
 - A **Select Program Group** window will appear. The default group should be ERAS 2009 (It is recommended you leave the default Program Group settings).
12. Click **Next**.
 - A **Destination Directory** dialog box appears. It asks you where to install the ERAS Program Director's Workstation. The default directory is **C:\ERASPDW.2K9**.
13. Click **Next**.
 - A **Ready to Install** dialog box appears, confirming your choice for the ERAS Program Director's Workstation Server directory path. If the path is correct, click on the **Start Install** button.
14. Once the installation is complete, you will receive the setup complete dialog box.
15. Click **Finish** to complete the installation.
