Therefore, following the release of the National Resident Matching Program (NRMP) match results, FindAResident will restrict access to its service based on individual match statuses as provided by the NRMP.

During the Scramble period in mid-March until July 1st applicants who have matched successfully with the NRMP may not use FindAResident to contact programs with open positions in the year that the applicant is matched.

Fully Matched Residency Applicants

- ⊘ You may not register with FindAResident if you are matched for both PGY1 and PGY2 positions through the NRMP.
- ⊘ Registered users matched for both PGY1 and PGY2 positions may not search for PGY1 or PGY2 positions in FindAResident.
- ⊘ Registered users matched for both PGY1 and PGY2 positions will not appear to programs searching for PGY1 nor PGY2 applicants.

Unmatched Residency Applicants

- ⊘ You may register with FindAResident if you did not match to a PGY1 or PGY2 position through the NRMP.
- ⊘ You may search and notify programs for either PGY1 or PGY2 positions.
- ⊘ You will appear in search results for programs searching for either PGY1 or PGY2.

Partially Matched Residency Applicants

- ⊘ You may register with FindAResident if you are unmatched for either a PGY1 or PGY2 position through the NRMP.
- ⊘ Registered users matched for PGY1 may not notify programs advertising for PGY1 level positions in FindAResident.
- ⊘ Registered users matched for PGY1 will not appear to programs searching for PGY1 applicants.
- ⊘ Registered users matched for PGY2 may not notify programs advertising for PGY2 level positions in FindAResident.
- ⊘ Registered users matched for PGY2 will not appear to programs searching for PGY2 applicants.

- ⊘ Residency candidates matched for both PGY1 and PGY2 positions will not appear in search results for either PGY1 or PGY2 applicants
- ⊘ Residency candidates matched for PGY1 will not appear in searches for PGY1 applicants.
- ⊘ Residency candidates matched for PGY2 will not appear in searches for PGY2 applicants.
- ⊘ Programs **may not** advertise PGY1 positions with Summer 2009 start dates until after Tuesday March 17, 2009, 12:00 p.m. EST.
- ⊘ Programs **may not** advertise PGY2 positions with Summer 2010 start dates until after Tuesday March 17, 2009, 12:00 p.m. EST.
