

Overview

The MCAT assesses facility with scientific problem solving requiring mastery of basic science concepts, critical thinking, and writing skills.

Content Outline

The MCAT has four sections:

- Physical Sciences (PS: physics and general chemistry)
- Verbal Reasoning (VR)
- Writing Sample (WS)
- Biological Sciences (BS: biology and organic chemistry)

Scoring

Numeric scores from 1 to 15 are reported for the multiple-choice test sections (PS, VR, and BS), and an alpha score from J to T for the WS essays. A total score, which is the sum of the three numeric scores with the WS score attached (e.g., 45T) is also reported.

Score Reports

Paper reports will be mailed beginning 60 days after test day. Online score reports will be available at that time (advance Web site registration required).

Sending Scores

MCAT scores will be automatically included in AMCAS applications and may be sent to other institutions using the MCAT Testing History (MCAT THx) reporting system online.
