

Pierre Buekens, MD, PhD



Dr. Pierre Buekens' is the W. H. Watkins Professor in the Department of Epidemiology at Tulane University School of Public Health and Tropical Medicine. Dr. Buekens' research focuses on reproductive epidemiology, including neglected tropical diseases (NTDs) and pregnancy, and he is the director of the Tulane Center for Emerging Reproductive and Perinatal Epidemiology ([CERPE](#)). His current research spans Chagas disease in Argentina, Honduras, and Mexico, and Zika virus in Honduras. He has worked extensively in Latin America and together with other researchers, he co-founded [Trop-G](#), a collaboration working to control and eliminate NTDs in high-risk areas around the Gulf of Mexico.
