Because the Spring '87 Program format is somewhat unorthodox, I have been asked to provide you with a brief explanation. There are at least two motives for changing the traditional format: 1) There appeared to be widespread interest in totally integrating into one program the GSA, MAS, and OSR membership. All three organizations will have their own business meetings, but for the program itself all will participate in this issue oriented program. 2) In reviewing feedback comments from the participants in the San Antonio meeting, as well as suggestions for program topics for '87, there were a number of common issues and concerns noted. Most of them could be categorized as to issues related to admissions/financial aid, curriculum/career counseling, professional conduct and moral and ethical concerns, and the problem of impaired students. We made the big assumption that the membership in GSA, MAS and OSR would be interested in discussing and hopefully proposing solutions to issues related to these four areas. Rather than having a variety of lecture type, round table, seminar and other small group type sessions, we plan to have the entire membership of the three organizations involved, arbitrarily assigned to one of four small groups for the duration of the meeting. All four small groups will meet together at the beginning of the four major sessions to hear keynote comments by selected individuals. Following these comments the small groups will meet separately and be guided by a moderator in their discussion of the issues previously identified by the keynoter. There will be two teams of moderators, one for the two sessions on Thursday and a different team of moderators for the two sessions on Friday.

You will note that the meeting actually begins on Wednesday evening at which time we will get the reports from the national offices in Washington. The final business meetings will be on Saturday morning. The schedule for social events are similar to those at past meetings.



The program chairman has received invaluable support from Cheryl Wilkes, Billy Rankin, Dottie Brinsfield, Lenny Lawrence and Jill Hankins. If you have any questions or comments about the program please feel free to contact me.

We hope that you will plan to attend the meeting and also to encourage colleagues who in the past have not attended this regional meeting to participate with us also.
