

GBAnalytics Survey #2 – Results Staffing Support for Financial Services

This report summarizes results of the GBA Data and Benchmarking Committee's second GBAnalytics survey. This survey, developed by a team from Indiana University's School of Medicine, focuses on staffing support for financial services. The survey was distributed to Principal Business Officers (PBOs) in April 2015, and thirtyfour schools participated in the survey.
