- The GBA PDC Assignment of Mentorship Circles

CONNECTING WITH YOUR CIRCLE

- Orientation call with AAMC and new circles
- Initial Connections between Co-Mentors and Mentees
- Defining a Meeting Schedule and Preferred Communication Methods
- Annual Curriculum Setting and Engagement
- Convening during the Spring GBA Conference (April 27-28)

EVALUATION AND FEEDBACK

- Formal Evaluations
- Feedback to the PDC

Participant Expectations: Mentors

- Attend the GBA Mentorship Circle session
- Attend selected GBA PDC Spring Conference/Webinars
- Introduce and facilitate the connection of the mentees to each other and other GBA members
- Define a meeting schedule
- Discuss and set realistic goals or areas of focus for their mentees
- Encourage the mentee to utilize GBA Resources
- Introduce mentees to potential ongoing GBA mentors in roles/areas of interest
- Complete GBA Mentorship Circle evaluation surveys to ensure continuous improvement in the program

- Submit an Application Opens shortly
 - An invitation to apply to participate in the program by completing an application survey will be sent.
- Welcome Email
 - A welcome email from the AAMC that contains information about how to become more engaged with the GBA and next steps related to the Mentorship Circle program.
- New Member Orientation
 - A new member orientation to be held virtually in January 2022; meet and greet of Mentorship Circles and celebration of prior year circles to be held annually at the GBA Annual Spring Conference (April 27-28, 2022 in San Francisco)
