### Limiting Student Ability to Apply to Electives Abroad jump to page

# Limiting Student Ability to Apply to Electives Abroad

This job aid provides guidance to home institutions on how to update students' access to apply to elective opportunities abroad.

#### **Home Institutions**

Home institutions who are in both the U.S. and Global networks and wish to limit their students' ability to apply to global opportunities will need to make their students **Ineligible for International Mobility**.

- 1) Edit an individual student's eligibility for International Mobility
  - a. Navigate to the Student Roster page
  - b. Select the **Class Year** or **Expected Graduation Date** to view the students you wish to update
  - c. The International Mobility column will display which of the students can apply to international opportunities
  - d. Select Edit in the Actions column for the student you wish to update.
  - e. In the Edit Student window, click "Ineligible for International Mobility"



- 2) Bulk edit student eligibility for International Mobility
  - a. Navigate to the Student Roster page
  - b. Select the **Class Year** or **Expected Graduation Date** to view the students you wish to update
  - c. Check the box to the left of the student name and AAMC ID, or check the box to select all students on the page



d. Select a Bulk Action menu, and select Ineligible for International Mobility



e. Review the Manage Students message and click Yes- I'm sure

Please note:

- The bulk eligibility update will only update students who have already accepted an invitation to VSAS (listed as Applicant).
- Students listed as Invited will need to have their eligibility updated after they accept the invitation and are listed as an Applicant
- Students listed as Not Invited, or with Expired invitations will have their eligibility set when invited or re-invited to VSAS.
- If you have students who have recently submitted applications for international opportunities, you will need to work with those students to discuss the next steps. These applications are still valid and can be processed.



## Mark Application(s) to Not Be Released

Home institutions may want or need to mark student applications that should not be released to a host institution. This may be a temporary step or may be the final home decision. Applications that are marked Not to be Released can still be released by the home institution, in most instances.

This job aid provides guidance to home institutions on how to mark an application as Not to be Released.

#### Not to be Released

Home institutions who wish to move an application that is Pending Release from their work flow because it will not or should not be released will need to mark the application(s) as **Io Not Release**.

- 1) Navigate to the Release page
- 2) By default, the page will be displaying all Pending applications that need to be reviewed

3) Find the application that should not be released, and select **Do Not Release** in the **Actions** column



4) Review and edit if necessary, the Do Not Release message. This email will be sent to the student.





- 5) Select Do Not Release and Notify
- 6) The application will be moved to the Not to be Released page

#### **Release a Not to be Released Application**

Home institutions may wish to release an application that has previously been marked as Not to be Released.

- 1) Navigate to the **Release** page
- 2) Select the view for Not to be Released
