New Resource: AAMC CI Technical User Guide 2022

A new resource, the [AAMC CI Technical User Guide for 2022](#), has been added to our [Resources for CI Developers webpage](#).

Please note that the AAMC CI Technical User Guide is to document the 2021-2022 curriculum, with uploading **beginning August 2022**. It is not meant for the 2021 upload, although you are welcome to read through it in case it helps inform your understanding of the 2021 data expectations. Just be sure to note the elements which are highlighted as requiring differences in 2022. The reason for this timing in 2022 is to coincide with **updates to the MedBiquitous CI Specifications**; the CI Technical User Guide 2022 references five MedBiquitous specifications which inform the AAMC CI.

The purpose of this new resource is to:

- Explain the AAMC CI's application of the MedBiquitous specifications,
- Articulate AAMC's expectations for each of the elements in schools' CI XML data files,
- Provide language from an educational and technical perspective to facilitate discussion and review,
- Bring together information previously found in multiple documents.

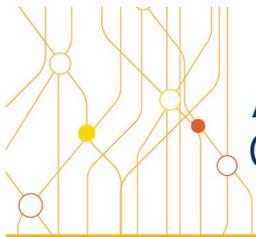
