

## MESRE Grant or Scholars Grant: Which one is right for you?

Constituents in the NEGEA are eligible to apply for both MESRE Research Grants, sponsored by the Medical Education Scholarship, Research, and Evaluation (MESRE) section, or NEGEA Scholars grants; but how do you decide? While complete information about each grant is available from their Calls for Proposals, a snapshot of key differences appears below.

	<b>MESRE Research Grant</b>	<b>Scholars Grant</b>
<b>Recipient</b>	PI is part of a team, preferably inter-institutional	PI is Individual grant recipient
<b>Type of Funded project</b>	Research, including program evaluation, prospective research, etc.	Research or professional development/curriculum design
<b>Proposal Length</b>	No more than 5 page (see RFP)	No more than 15 pages
<b>Deadline</b>	September 30, 2022 at 11:59pm	September 30, 2022 at 11:59pm
<b>Grant Amount Maximum</b>	\$3,000 for single institution; \$6,000 for multi-institutional projects (2 or more)	\$15,000
<b>Required Institutional Match</b>	None	\$5,000 support from Institution
<b>Funded timeframe</b>	2 years	2 years to complete project
