


VSLO Application Service Update

New Look, Same Content and Functionality


The Visiting Student Learning Opportunities (VSLO) Application Service is getting a new look and feel. This new design is happening across all AAMC services. There are some important changes to the VSLO application navigation, but no changes to the processes or workflows. Additionally, we are simplifying and standardizing how we refer to the application service: VSLO.
