Notes: The U.S. MD Graduates cohort includes all U.S. MD medical school graduates in the corresponding academic year, who were also reported in training in a residency program in any GME year in GME Track. Medical school graduates not reported in GME Track are excluded. The residency program to medical school affiliations refer to the first residency program of training and are based on information reported in the 2022 GME Track Program Survey, or the name of the residency program, or the sponsoring institution of the residency program. For the purposes of this report, the 2022 affiliations between residency programs and medical schools are assumed to have been in place in previous GME years.
