- Biographical Sketch and/or Resume/Curriculum vitae

We ask that nominations packets are submitted as one document, either PDF or Word, that includes all materials required for consideration.

GRMC Steering Committee members must be at a member institution accredited by the Liaison Committee on Medical Education (LCME) or the Committee on Accreditation of Canadian Medical Schools (CACMS), or at a Council of Teaching Hospitals (COTH) member hospital.
