

**Table B-6.1: Total Graduates by U.S. MD-Granting Medical School and Race/Ethnicity (Alone), 2022-2023**



The table below displays the racial and ethnic characteristics (alone) of graduates in U.S. medical schools for 2022-2023. "Alone" indicates those graduates who selected only one race/ethnicity category. The "Multiple Race/Ethnicity" category includes those graduates who selected more than one race/ethnicity category. The "Multiple Race/Ethnicity" counts may include graduates who self-identified in a race/ethnicity category that the reader may wish to count as underrepresented in medicine (URiM), as well as graduates whom the reader may not wish to count as underrepresented—as a result, the data in this table cannot be used to calculate a unique count of individuals who identify as URiM. The AAMC definition of Underrepresented in Medicine found at <https://www.aamc.org/what-we-do/diversity-inclusion/underrepresented-in-medicine> is: "Underrepresented in medicine means those racial and ethnic populations that are underrepresented in the medical profession relative to their numbers in the general population." This AAMC definition allows for a variety of ways to conceptualize URiM, depending on whether (for example) one is looking at the national perspective, regional perspective, or local perspective. The "Non-U.S. Citizen and Non-Permanent Resident" category may include graduates with unknown citizenship.
