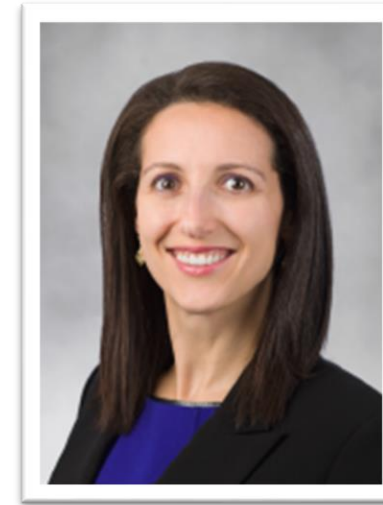

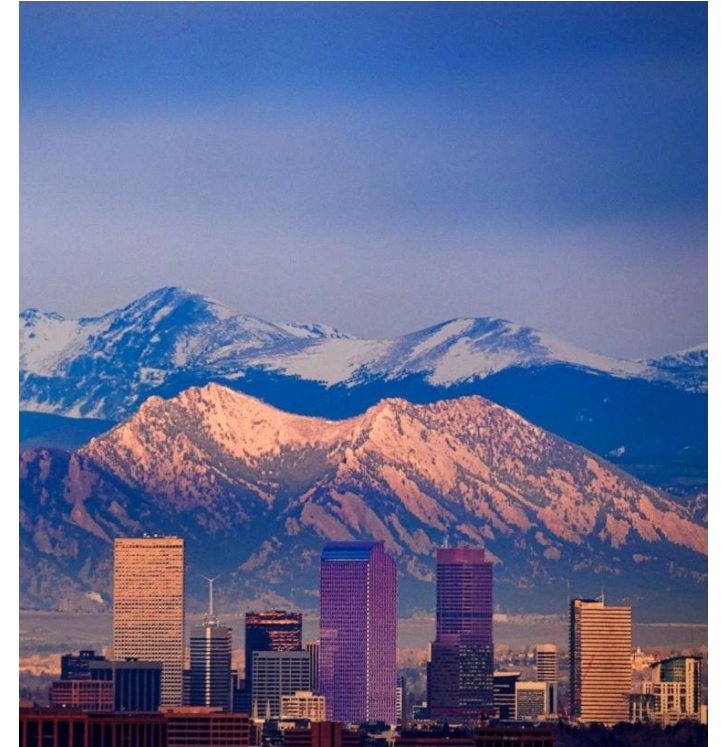

- ☐ In **even years**, the GIR Medical School IT Survey collects information about IT services at medical schools, such as leadership organization, reporting structure, budget, staffing, and services.
- ☐ In **odd years**, the survey collects information about IT applications for administrative, educational, clinical, research, regulatory/compliance management, and security purposes.
- ☐ GIR Medical School Representatives at participating medical schools receive a data file of responses.
