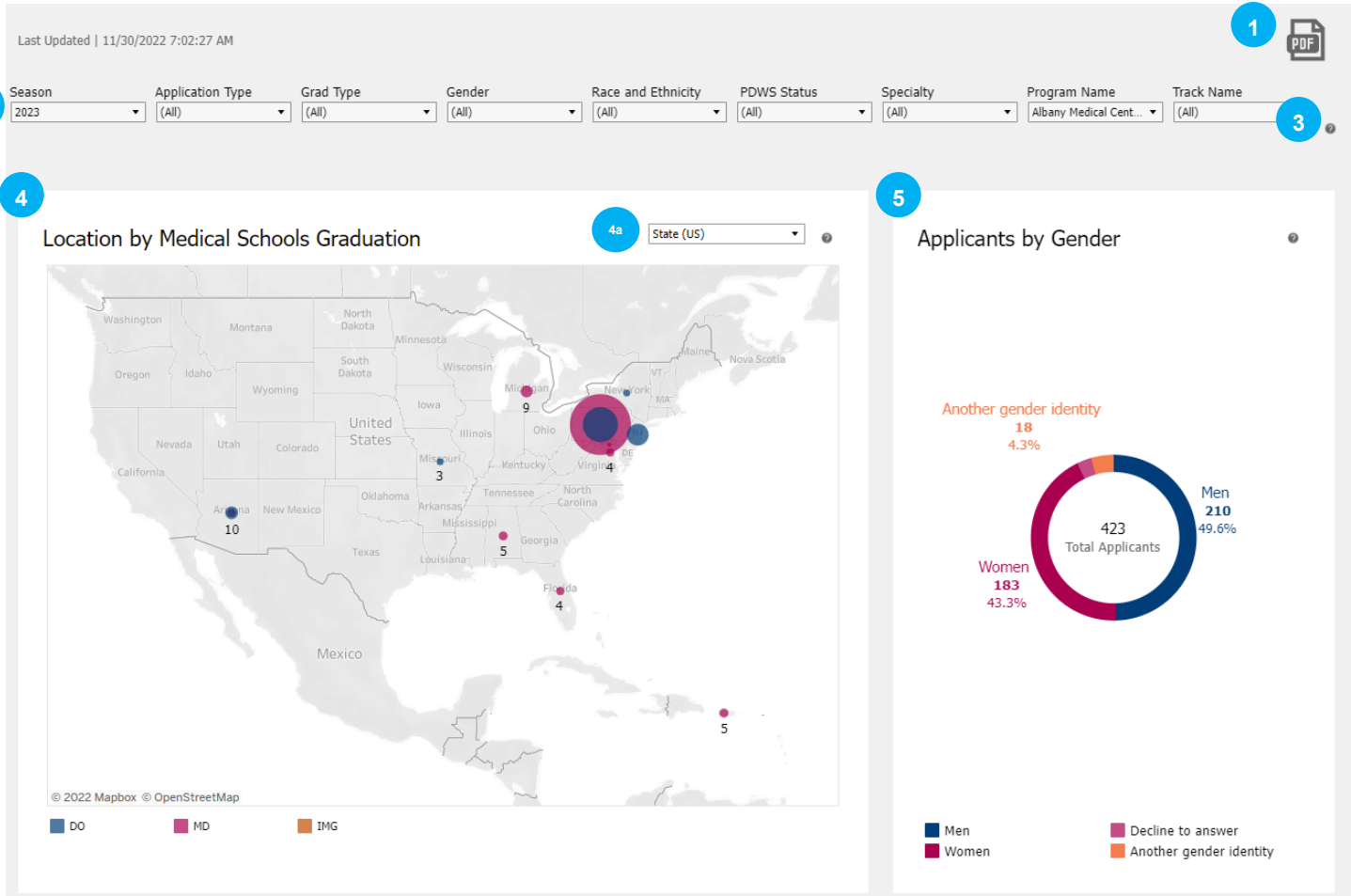


This report provides a breakdown of demographic information about your applicants in your institution.

### 5 Applicants by Gender

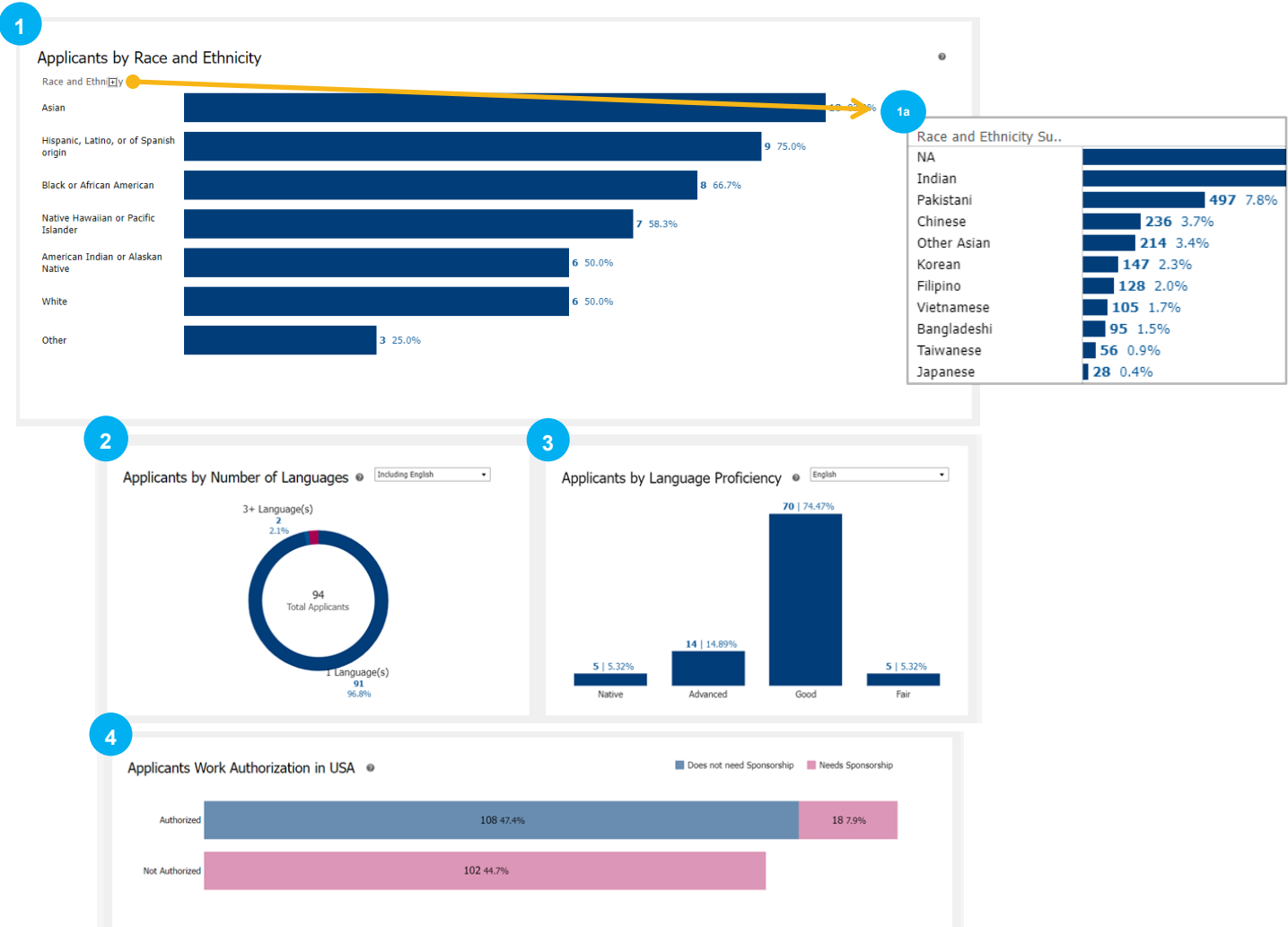
Groups applicants into the following categories based on their selections in MyERAS:

Each category shows the unique number of applicants and the percentage of total applicants.

The number in the center is the number of total of unique applicants.

### 1 Applicants by Race and Ethnicity

Applicants by their Race and Ethnicity selections in MyERAS. Applicants are able to make more than one selection (see the Race and Ethnicity report for more details).

Applicants are not required to report this information.

#### 1a Race and Ethnicity sub categories

Hover over each column to reveal a '+' or '-' icon to drill down or drill up the data for race/ethnicity sub-categories.

If an applicant selects a major category they are not required to select a sub category.

### 2 Applicants by Number of Languages

Applicants by number of languages they reported speaking in MyERAS.

The drop-down menu has two options:

- Including English
- Other than English

With the first option, Including English, English is counted as one of the languages spoken.

In the second option, Other than English, English is excluded from the counts of languages spoken.

Applicants must list at least one language but English is not required to be listed.

### 3 Applicants by Language Proficiency

Applicants by their language proficiency for the selected language.

The proficiency levels in descending order are: **Native, Advanced, Good, Fair, Basic.**

### 4 Applicants Work Authorization in USA

Applicants by their current work authorization in the USA.

The categories of **Needs Sponsorship** and **Does not need Sponsorship** indicate the future work authorization needs.
