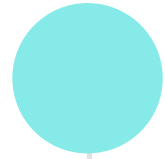
Group on Regional Medical Campuses (GRMC)

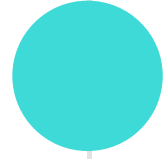
- Approximately 1 out of 3 medical schools have at least one regional medical campus with over 120 in North America.

- Membership open to leaders, staff, and faculty at regional medical campuses and main campuses.



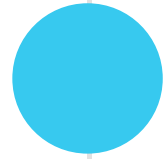

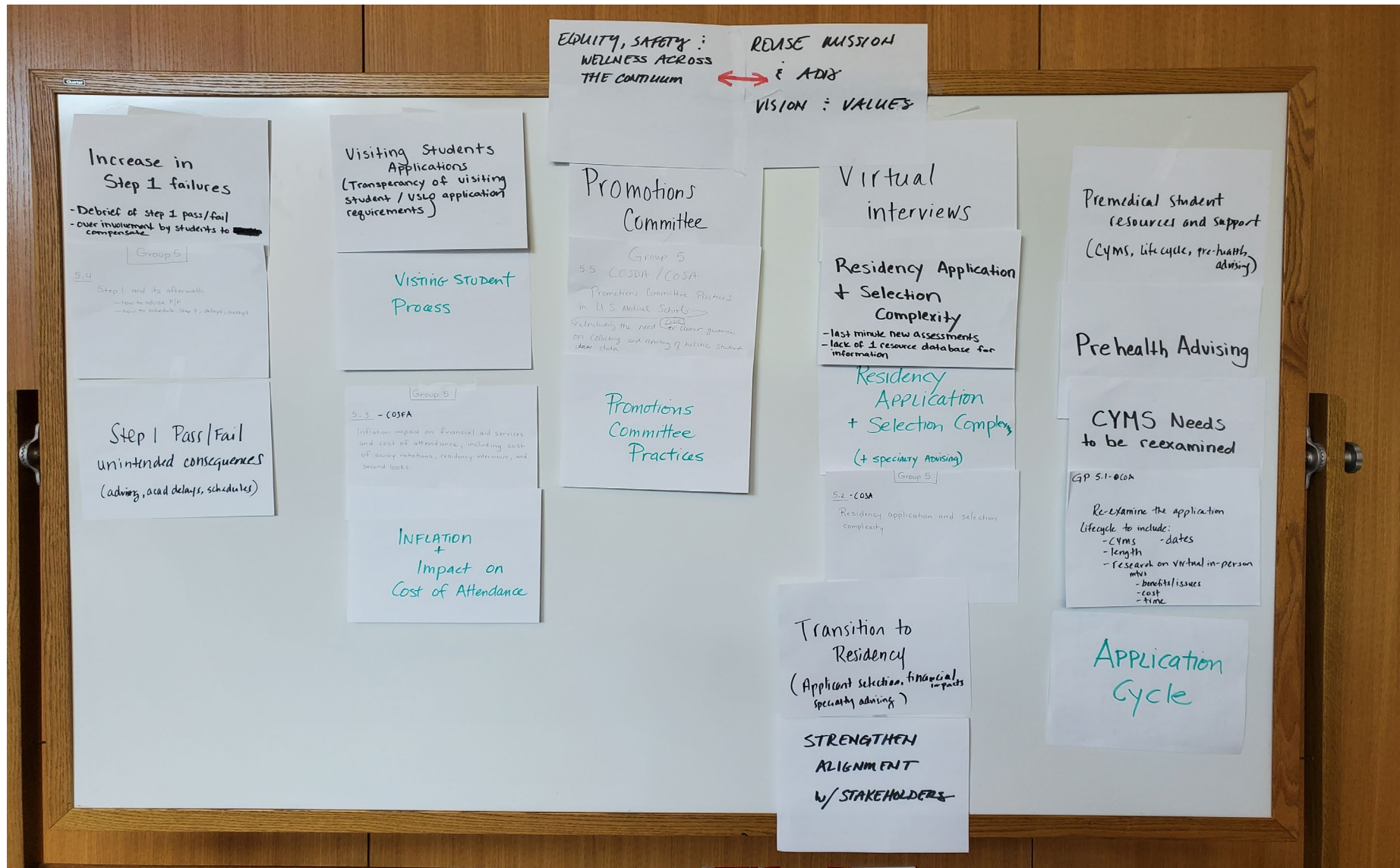
GSA National Meetings

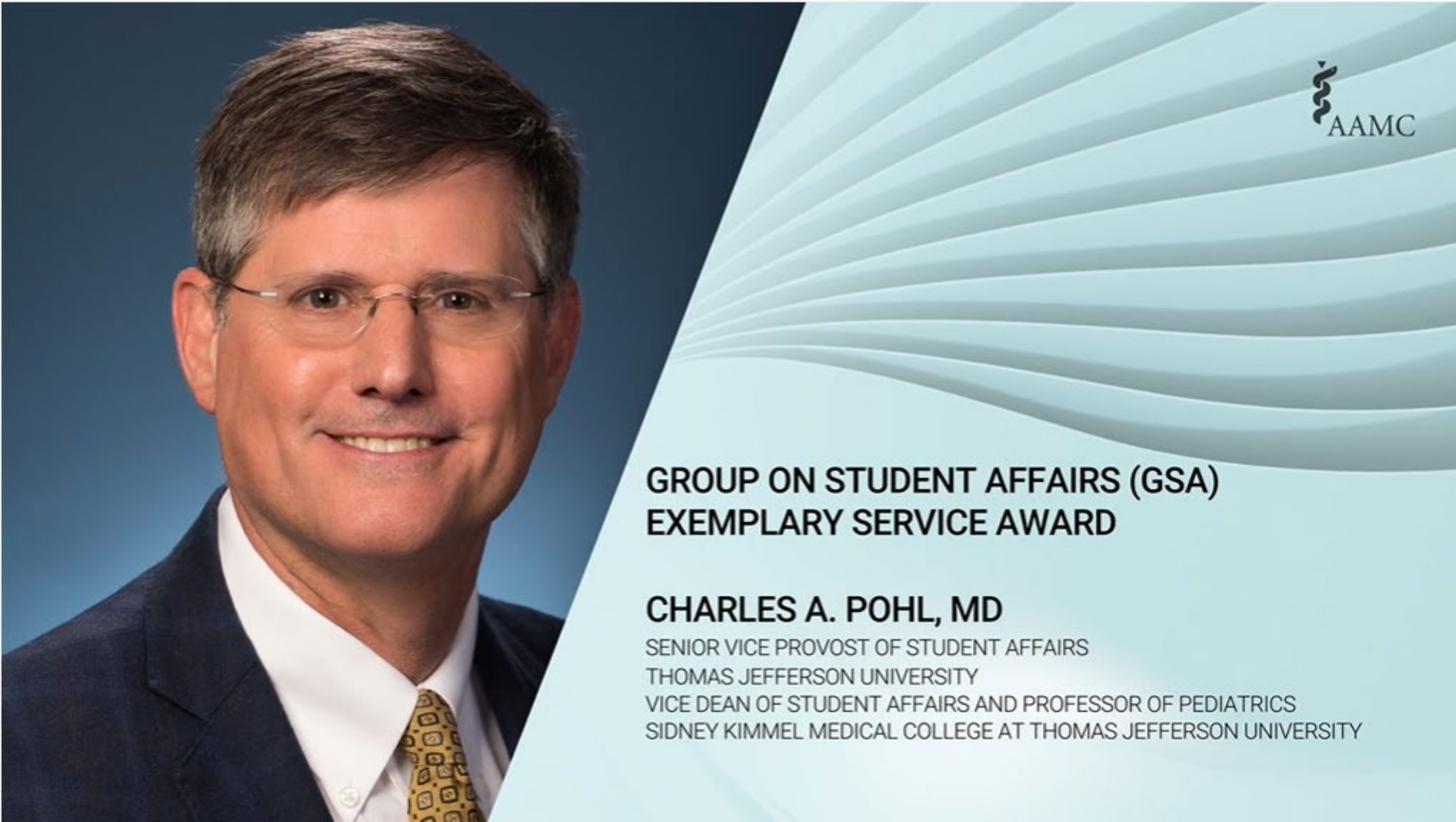
