¹ In 2013, the methodology for acquiring race/ethnicity information was updated. Rather than one question asking an applicant's Hispanic origin and a second question asking the applicant's race, the Hispanic origin and race response options are now listed together under a single question about how applicants self-identify. Applicants could select multiple response options.

² Four applicants in 2013 and six applicants in 2014 who declined to report gender are not reflected.

³ The counts for "Black or African American" and "Hispanic, Latino, or of Spanish Origin" categories include those who indicated these main categories regardless of whether they also selected a sub-category.

⁴ "Multiple Race/Ethnicity" includes those who indicated more than one race or ethnicity category (e.g., "Black or African American" and "American Indian or Alaska Native", "Hispanic, Latino, or of Spanish Origin" and "White").
