The table below displays the race and ethnicity self-identification (alone or in combination) of graduates of U.S. medical schools for 2021-2022. Alone or in combination indicates those graduates who self-identify in a race/ethnicity category alone or in combination with another race/ethnicity category. The sum of the race/ethnicity categories may not add to the total number of graduates since a graduate could designate multiple race/ethnicity categories. Also, the sum of the graduates in the underrepresented categories may not add to the Unduplicated Total URiM Graduates since graduates could designate multiple underrepresented categories.
