¹First-year enrollment includes first-year students who are not on a research leave of absence. Most first-year students enrolled at programs that do not follow the traditional 2-4-2 model (the first 2 years of medical school, followed by 4 years of graduate school, and ending with the last 2 years of medical school) are accounted for in the research-LOA enrollment counts.

²Research-LOA enrollment includes any student, regardless of current class level, whose current enrollment status is "Participating in Joint Degree Program".

³Total Enrollment includes all students enrolled as medical students, including students on a leave of absence.
