

## Call for Nominations: AAMC's Medical Education Planning Committee

We invite you to submit self-nominations for service on the **AAMC's Medical Education Planning Committee** for November 2024 – November 2027.

The **AAMC's Medical Education Planning Committee** is responsible for selecting abstracts and sessions submitted through the call for submissions for the AAMC's Annual Meeting: Learn Serve Lead (LSL). We seek self-nominations of medical educators from across the continuum of medical education and with a variety of backgrounds to fill vacancies.

The **AAMC's Medical Education Planning Committee Members** are responsible for reviewing the abstract and session submissions and peer review comments submitted through the call for submissions for the AAMC's Annual Meeting. Most of the work of the committee happens during the submission review period in January and February (done independently) and at the two-day virtual meeting in February (done as a group). Newly elected members begin their three-year term at the end of the AAMC's Annual Meeting.

The **AAMC's Medical Education Planning Committee** is comprised of leaders in the field of medical education. As such, we seek nominees who:

- Have demonstrated scholarly activity
- Have attended and/or presented at previous AAMC LSL or spring GEA meetings
- Have experience reviewing/editing manuscripts for medical education journals
- Are willing to serve for a three-year term
- Are available to participate in regularly scheduled conference calls once a month or less
- Are available to participate in a two-day virtual meeting in **late February**

### Nominations

Self-nominations are due no later than **August 15, 11:59pm PT**. Include the following information with your nomination:

1. Your name, degree(s), and institutional affiliation(s)
2. A brief CV (no more than 2 pages)
3. A list of your participation in local, regional, national, and/or international medical education activities (no more than 1 page)
4. A letter describing why you would like to serve on the Medical Education Planning Committee (no more than 500 words)
5. A completed Areas-of-Expertise Inventory (available for download [here](#))
