

# 2 Global Dashboard Filters

The "Specialty Name" filter can be adjusted using a drop-down menu to show only relevant students and applications across all cards.

# 3 ERAS Interviews by Month | Filtering This View

This view can be filtered on one or more selected ERAS Seasons, in addition to the global dashboard filter for Specialty Name. The "Select Date" drop-down menu switches between showing counts of "Invited" dates or "Interview" dates, as represented by the bars in the chart.

# 4 ERAS Interviews by Month | About This View

This chart provides users with a high-level overview of ERAS interview trends from current and past seasons by specialty. The bars in the chart represent either the count of interview invitations received ("Invited"), or the count of scheduled interview dates ("Interview"), in the month shown along the horizontal axis, by the Specialty Name, given in the left axis, and by ERAS Season, given by the colored bars. Users can switch between the "Invited" date or "Interview" date using the "Select Date" drop-down menu located above the chart.

Please note, this view shows aggregated data from all institutions, regardless of your home institution.

# 5 VSLO Rotations by Month | About This View

This chart provides users with an overview of VSLO rotations being offered in the current and next VSLO Academic Year. The bars show the number of elective rotations, colored by VSLO Academic Year, which are scheduled to begin in the month given by the horizontal axis, and which are associated with the Specialty given by the left axis.

Please note, this view shows aggregated data from all institutions, regardless of your home institution.

### 7 Accepted Alumni Electives | Filtering This View

This view can be filtered by "Application Year" and "Program Name" using the drop-down menus located on the top-right of the card. The "Application Year" is the Academic Year in which the student created the VSLO application.

#### 8 Accepted Alumni Electives | About This View

This chart provides with information about prior VSLO academic year students who have accepted a VSLO rotation.

The treemap chart is divided by the Program Name of the host institution (separated by the thick white borders), and further by the VSLO academic year in which the applications were submitted by the student (separated by thin white borders). The relative size of each element is determined by the number of applications submitted to the given host Program; the color of each element represents the number of applications accepted by the host Program, with light gray representing the smallest number of accepted applications in the scale, and deep blue representing the largest number in the scale.

The Program Name, VSLO Academic Year, Total Application Count, and Accepted Application Count are shown in a tooltip when hovering over a treemap element; treemap elements may also be labeled with some or all of these quantities, if the element is large enough to fit the label.

Please note, clicking on any of the treemap elements will bring the User to the Accepted Alumni Electives Detail View. The Detail View will be


#### 10 Accepted Alumni Electives Detail | About This View

This detail table will appear when a square of the **Accepted Alumni Electives** treemap is clicked on. The detail table is automatically filtered to the corresponding Program Name and Application Year. The table provides additional information about alumni of the VSLO program from the user's home institution, including the names of the alumni, the Elective Name of the rotation they attended, the Specialty Name of the corresponding Elective. The VSLO application status and student decision status are also displayed.



#### 15 Top 10 Cross Applications | About This View

This chart shows up to ten of the most common pairs of Specialties to which students have submitted ERAS applications in the given ERAS Season (or seasons). The labels for each bar show the two Specialties, separated by "//". The number of students who have applied to both of the given specialties is also given, following the "|" separator.

**Please note**, clicking on any of the bars in this chart will filter the "Cross Application - Detailed" View, such that only students who cross applied to both specialties given in the selected bar will be shown.


# 16 Cross Application - Detailed | About This View


#### 21 Student Status - VSLO Current Year | About This View

The table in this view shows the status of VSLO applications started in the current VSLO Academic Year. A count of the number of electives for which a student has created an application is shown in the right-most column. Student VSLO applications are further broken down by the Specialty of the Elective and the Program Name of the host institution. The Application Status for the corresponding applications is also given for each Specialty and host Program.
