On behalf of the Friends of VA Medical Care and Health Research (FOVA), a coalition of over 80 organizations dedicated to advancing the VA research mission, we write to express our deep concern regarding the federal hiring freeze and the recent mass dismissal of VA employees. These actions will have an immediate and detrimental impact on veteran care, patient safety, and the groundbreaking medical research conducted at VA medical centers nationwide.

Among the critical roles affected by these measures are physicians, nurses, patient coordinators, clinicianscientists, and other essential medical personnel—positions already experiencing significant shortages across the VA system. The loss of these professionals will result in longer wait times, diminished access to specialized care, and compromised patient safety.

Additionally, the hiring freeze is crippling VA research, threatening medical innovation and putting lifesaving treatments for veterans at risk. Key studies on cancer treatments, opioid addiction, prosthetics, suicide prevention, and toxic exposures face disruption or cancellation. The impact of these interruptions extends far beyond research institutions—it directly affects veterans who rely on these clinical trials and interventions.

According to data collected by NAVREF Membership, by April 20<sup>th</sup>, 2025, the hiring freeze could result in:

- The suspension or cancellation of **370 extramural studies and clinical trials**,
- Up to 10,000 veterans losing access to critical treatments provided through these studies,
- The loss of \$35 million in VA research funding,
- The departure of essential principal investigators and research coordinators.

The urgency of this matter cannot be overstated. We urge the Administration and Congress to **immediately halt and rescind the dismissals of key medical and research staff** and to **exempt all roles related to medical care and research from the federal hiring freeze**. These actions are necessary to protect veteran health, maintain medical research momentum, and prevent irreparable harm to VA's ability to deliver high-quality care.

FOVA welcomes the opportunity to collaborate with policymakers to develop solutions that preserve the integrity of VA medical care and research. We stand ready to provide further information on the hiring freeze's impact and to assist in crafting policies that ensure veterans continue receiving the highest standard of care they deserve.

We ask for your immediate attention to this crisis and urge you to work with us to safeguard the future of VA healthcare and research. Please do not hesitate to contact us for further discussion.
