Healthcare Professions Trainee (Without Compensation) Pilot Day -1 Readiness

- HPT TQCVL received
- HPE enters HPT in APDS
- HPT is sponsored in APDS, which flows to USAccess (all fields except UPN and VA email)
- HPT completes onboarding forms and submits
- HPT Completes eAPP (within 3-5 days)
- PerSec/PIV Office confirms ID and FP scan completed/released
- PerSec enters data in VA CABS
- PerSec initiates eAPP (SF-85) review

- PerSec confirms BI is scheduled, enters SAC and Investigation "scheduled date"
- PerSec notifies HPE of favorable interim adjudication in VA CABS (unfavorable determination stops process, non-select letter routed from PerSec to HPE)
- OIT creates Active Directory and email accounts



- PIV Office receives/checks in card
- USAccess sends email to HPT for activation appointment (local sponsor needs to advise HPT not to arrive until day 1)

- Days on timeline indicate number of days before start date.
- > HPT steps are in blue
- HPE notification to PerSec/OS via SharePoint
- PerSec reviews forms
- PerSec initiates NBIS eAPP
- HPT schedules FP scan appointment (Online Scheduler). What to bring: Source Document Link
- PerSec FP SAC adjudication and eAPP (SF-85) released to DCSA
- Non-US Citizen vetting validated by PerSec

Automated: Sponsorship is validated, APDS creates the AD account and automates final PIV sponsorship with VA email and UPN.

If selected at Sponsorship, this triggers the Central Print Process (the location of print was specified at initial sponsorship).

HPT reports to medical facility

 PIV credential is activated (HR completes signing ceremony)

Ideally, process steps identified before day 30 on the map should be done as soon as possible within the 120-day range - this will ensure day 1 readiness.
