


Join the GDI Virtual Community!

In order to join the GDI Virtual Community, you must first create an AAMC Virtual Communities login, if you do not already have one. Please note that the GDI Virtual Community is a space designed for current GDI members.

Follow these instructions to create an account and join:

1. Visit the <u>AAMC Virtual Communities</u> and select the **Not Registered Yet? Request an Account** button at the bottom of the login prompt (as shown in the image below).



- 2. On the **Request an Account** page, complete your account information. All fields marked with the red asterisk (*) are required.
- 3. The **username** is your email address. (*Note: The Virtual Communities platform is separate from your OneAAMC account. However, for consistency, you can use the same email address and password when creating your Virtual Communities account.)*
- 4. Although not marked as required, please fill out the **Job Function** line so we can recommend communities that might be the best fit for you.





5. For Which community (or communities) are you trying to join?, please select Group on Diversity and Inclusion (GDI) from the drop-down menu.

- 6. Select **Sign In** to complete your AAMC Communities account.
- 7. It can take up to **2-3 business days** for the account to be approved. After the AAMC Communities account is approved, you will receive a welcome email.

Ask your IT department or vendor to add the following domain to your organization's allow list: connectedcommunity.org.

8. Once you're approved, you will receive a weekly digest from the GDI Community. Please <u>adjust</u> <u>your settings (video)</u> to your preference under the profile tab. By default, you will be added to the **Academic Medicine Open Forum** Community.
