



## How to Update your Program(s) Participation Status


ERAS® program registration runs from April through the end of May. To receive applications in the ERAS system, programs must register to indicate that they will have open positions and will use the ERAS program. Programs are encouraged to update their participation status for the upcoming ERAS season before the current season ends on May 31.

Please note: Programs are automatically opted in to use Thalamus Cortex, Core, Itinerary Wizard, and Cerebellum when they complete registration for the 2026 ERAS season. Bulk onboarding to Thalamus will begin on Wednesday, June 4, 2025, when the 2026 ERAS season opens. 1. Navigate to the <u>ERAS® Program Director's WorkStation (PDWS)</u> and enter your AAMC username and password.



- 2. Navigate to the Program Management tab and select the appropriate ERAS season.
  - a. Note: Only users with Program Management, ISU, AISU, PSU, APSU, and Program Management roles in the PDWS have access to view the Program Management tab in the PDWS.
- 3. Click the program name.








- 4. Read and Accept the ERAS and Thalamus Terms and Conditions.
- 5. Select the drop-down menu to view participation options.
  - a. The red arrow indicates the program's status. Programs that have not registered to participate in the current ERAS application season are marked as Unregistered.




- 6. Select **Will have open positions** and **Will use ERAS** to receive applications for the upcoming season.
  - a. Please select the appropriate status if your program **WILL NOT** use ERAS or accept applications for the upcoming season.







7. After selecting a participation status, click **Save**. A confirmation message will appear once the status has been saved successfully.



8. After saving, the program status will change to Participating, and additional program information will appear.







- 9 Specialties participating in <u>program signals</u> will automatically have their participation status set to "yes." Programs can opt out by selecting "no." The deadline for opting out is as follows, based on program cycles:
  - a. July Cycle: June 18, 2025, at 5:00 PM EST
  - b. September Cycle: August 20, 2025, at 5:00 PM EST
  - c. December Cycle: October 29, 2025, at 5:00 PM EST
    - i. Please note that participation status cannot be updated after the deadlines listed above for each program cycle.
