ERAS® program registration runs from April through the end of May. To receive applications in the ERAS system, programs must register to indicate that they will have open positions and will use the ERAS program. Programs are encouraged to update their participation status for the upcoming ERAS season before the current season ends on May 31.

Please note: Programs are automatically opted in to use Thalamus Cortex, Core, Itinerary Wizard, and Cerebellum when they complete registration for the 2027 ERAS season. When applicants request transmission of their transcripts, the NBME and NBOME provide designated recipients with a complete testing and score history, as well as information relating to exam administration incidents.
