

Table B-5.2: Total Enrollment by U.S. MD-Granting Medical School and Race/Ethnicity (Alone or In Combination), 2023-2024



The table below displays the race and ethnicity self-identification (alone or in combination) of enrolled students in U.S. medical schools for 2023-2024. Alone or in combination indicates those students who self-identify in a race/ethnicity category alone or in combination with another race/ethnicity category. The sum of the race/ethnicity categories may not add to the total number of students since a student could designate multiple race/ethnicity categories. Also, the sum of the students in the underrepresented categories may not add to the Unduplicated Total URiM Enrollment since students could designate multiple underrepresented categories. The AAMC definition of Underrepresented in Medicine found at <https://www.aamc.org/what-we-do/diversity-inclusion/underrepresented-in-medicine> is: "Underrepresented in medicine means those racial and ethnic populations that are underrepresented in the medical profession relative to their numbers in the general population." This AAMC definition allows for a variety of ways to conceptualize URiM, depending on whether (for example) one is looking at the national perspective, regional perspective, or local perspective. For the purposes of this particular FACTS table, a URiM student is any U.S. citizen or permanent resident who self-identified as one or more of the following race/ethnicity categories (alone or in combination with any other race/ethnicity category): American Indian or Alaska Native; Black or African American; Hispanic, Latino, or of Spanish Origin; or Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander. In this display, the race/ethnicity categories are reported only for U.S. citizens and permanent residents. The "Non-U.S. Citizen and Non-Permanent Resident" category may include students with unknown citizenship.
