- NIEHS Staff begin work with OSHA and NIOSH as part of the Unified Command to assess worker safety issues on May 1, 2010

NIEHS Oil Spill Research

National Toxicology Program:

- Exhaustive literature search
- Website for federal partners
- Toxicological studies to identify important biological and tissue targets for crude oil fractions as are appearing in the gulf.





NIEHS Oil Spill Research

Extramural Grant Funding:

- Collaborative funding from NIEHS and 8 other NIH IC's (NHLBI, NCI, NIAMS, NIMH, NIMHD, NINR, NCRR, OBSSR)
- Comprehensive research portfolio for University-Community consortia, to include monitoring, exposure and risk assessment, communication, and outreach
- RFA posted Oct 29, 2010, closed Jan 21, 2011, reviewed May 2011
- Additional center core grants, exploratory grants, and cooperative agreements for oil-related research projects



NIEHS Oil Spill Research

Intramural Research:

- Gulf Long-term Follow-up (GuLF) Study
- Assess health effects associated with oil spill cleanup following Deepwater Horizon disaster
- Investigate biomarkers of adverse biological effects
- Create a resource for future collaborative research
