4. **Read the [Curriculum Inventory In Context](#) publication.** This regularly issued commentary article combines U.S. and Canadian medical school curriculum data and the latest literature to explore and advance emerging issues and innovations in undergraduate medical education curriculum and curriculum mapping. Several data sets are leveraged to support findings including, the AAMC Curriculum Inventory and the Liaison Committee on Medical Education (LCME) Annual Questionnaire Part II. Because the publication provides both a synthesis of the literature on a given topic as well as graphical data, the resulting publication acts as a brief to help educators quickly get up to speed on a given topic.
5. **Explore the [CI website](#).** CI website content is organized according to these major categories:
 - [Curriculum Reports](#).** There are over 50 publicly available curriculum reports which are generated from two sets of data: the AAMC Curriculum Inventory, and the LCME Annual Questionnaire, Part II. Faculty from medical schools which participate in the annual AAMC Curriculum Inventory (CI) are eligible to make free custom curriculum data report requests. **Please submit your data requests [here](#).** Please try to limit your request to a single curriculum topic per request. Please be sure to clearly document your research and publication intentions along with your data request.
 - [Resources to establish a curriculum inventory](#).** These are foundational documents that a school relatively new to establishing a curriculum inventory, or in the midst of a significant continuous quality improvement effort, might find useful.
 - [Resources to use a curriculum inventory effectively](#).** These resources are intended for those who have an established curriculum inventory and are interested in ways to use their CI data.



[Resources for developers and vendors](#). These resources are intended for developers, vendors, or CI users who are interested in better understanding the technical infrastructure necessary to support a curriculum inventory, and to successfully share it with others.
