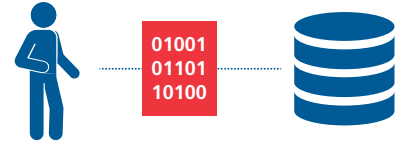


# CREDIT FOR DATA SHARING

## PROCESS AND ROLES

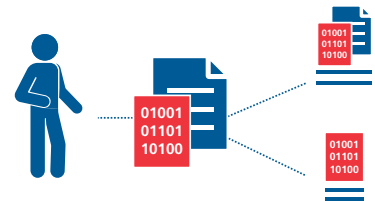

Researchers deposit datasets into repositories, associating each dataset with one or more ORCID iDs, which identify individuals. Repositories assign unique persistent identifiers (PIDs) to each dataset.



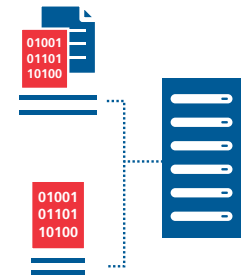

Authors submit the dataset PID(s) with each manuscript to enable future tracking.



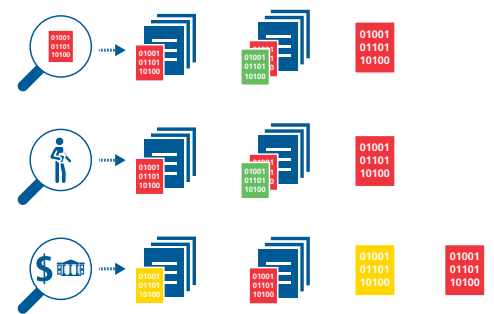

Publishers make links between papers and datasets available in the citation metadata.

Searchable systems allow tracking of datasets through dataset PID, ORCID iD, or grant or organization identifiers.

Individuals and organizations use citation information and metrics to assess impact of shared data.
